

## MIS 301 HTML Project Requirements: (Due 2/21/2008)

**Project Requirements:** For this HTML project, you are required to create your own homepage and then post it to your UAH web page account. I am liberal about the content of your homepage. However, following requirements should be followed.

1. Create a HTML file with two frames. Name it as index.htm. **(5 points)**
2. Create one HTML file for each frame. Name them frame1.htm and frame2.htm respectively. **(5 points)**
3. Insert at least 3 hyperlinks in frame1. One of them should be linked to my homepage at <http://cas.uah.edu/lixi>. All hyperlinks should be designed to control the content of frame2. In other words, when users click those links, the content of frame1 should NOT be changed. **(5 points)**
4. Insert a button in frame1. The text on it should be "Go Back". When clicked, it should reload the original content of frame2 back. **(5 points)**
5. Make the background colors of both frame1 and frame2 "ivory". **(5 points)**
6. Choose an appropriate title for your page. Center it in frame2. Bold and italicize the title. Set the font size of the title to "+4". Choose an appropriate color for the title. Type your full name below the title. **(5 points)**
7. Insert one horizontal line right below the title and your name. **(5 points)**
8. Create a 2\*2 table in frame2 and make it invisible. Insert a graphic file in this table. Link it to one of your favorite web sites. Insert a bulleted list in another cell of the table. Use it to list 4 classes you have taken at UAH. **(10 points)**
9. You are encouraged to add some other features to your web pages. Bonus will be given to students whose web pages are nicely designed. Bonus will also be given to those students who use HTML codes instead of Frontpage. **(Up to 5 bonus points)**
10. Post all finished documents to [http://webpages.uah.edu/~your\\_user\\_name](http://webpages.uah.edu/~your_user_name) **(5 points)**

Note: You can either use Frontpage or write HTML programs. However, HTML coding is strongly encouraged. Post your finished web pages and all graphics files to your UAH web page account via Ftp. How to use FTP? A helpful link <http://cas.uah.edu/tutorials/ftp.htm>

You can directly save the files to the Public\_html folder. If some of you have already created index.htm in this folder and may not want to overwrite it, please create a new folder called MIS\_301 under Public\_html and send all files there.
